The couple spent three years searching for the perfect location and looked at over one hundred sites, eventually drawn to the warm slopes and free-draining chalk soils of the Stonor Valley in Oxfordshire. The land was previously used for lowland grazing, with no crops grown on these soils for nearly five hundred years. This unfaltering attention to detail shines through in every aspect of production, from the state-of-the-art winery to the seamless visitor experience that awaits guests. It is unsurprising that the estate is fast gaining recognition as one of the most ambitious and exciting names in the English wine industry.

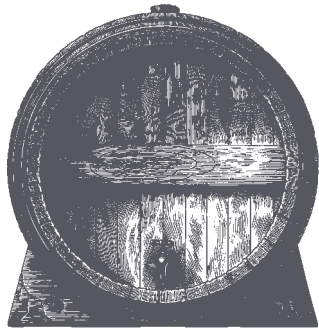

It is has a south-eastern exposure and is located at an altitude of 230m on the site of an old Gallo-Roman villa named Ambassacius. The vineyard covers 3 hectares. After vinification the wine is aged in oak barrels for around 10 months.

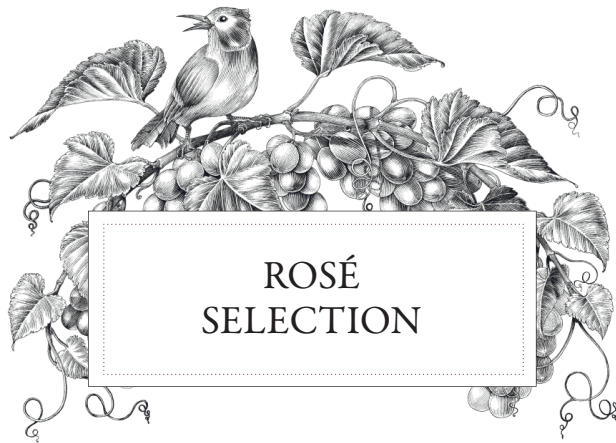
