... an independently owned restaurant with rooms; proud to be located in the heart of the city of Ripon, in the shadows of the stunning Ripon Cathedral. This Jacobean mansion dates back to 1625 and was originally built as a home for the Dean of Ripon.

In 2021 the venue was taken over by Rebecca and Chris (plus Cooper the toddler, and Toby the dog), and for two years The Old Deanery was an exclusive use weddings and events venue.

At the end of 2023, acclaimed chef, Adam Jackson was invited to the team as we transformed The Old Deanery into a fine dining restaurant with rooms.

In our first year, we were delighted to be awarded 3 AA Rosettes, and since the beginning of 2025 we have been MICHELIN recommended, marking us as a top dining destination. We have also been listed in the Hardens' top 100 UK restaurants.

As an independently owned business, each of our suppliers is carefully hand-picked, and with Yorkshire Vintners being so local to us (and thoroughly nice people!), it was an obvious choice to pair with them for our wine offering.

Since their beginnings in 2010, they have worked with the wines from both emerging and established wine regions around the world, bringing their stories to their customers.

## Sparkling Wine & Champagne

- 1      **Tallero Prosecco NV, Treviso, Italy**      £35.00  
Pale straw in colour with a persistent mousse. Floral aromas with peach and pear fruit on the palate.
- 2      **Cremant de Loire NV Mazelles, Loire Valley, France**      £45.00  
Pale with green hints, accompanied by an effervescence on the palate. Elegant fruit and honeysuckle on the nose, very gentle and delicate.
- 3      **Nyetimber Classic Cuvee West Sussex, England**      £60.00  
Deliciously fresh with notes of green and white fruits and elegant biscuit aromas.
- 4      **Nyetimber Rose NV, West Sussex, England**      £65.00  
High intensity, with lovely round and full but soft texture. Finish is very long and full, with red currant and hints of shortcrust pastry.
- 5      **Champagne Thienot Brut NV, Reims, France**      £60.00  
Beautiful pale, silky golden colour. The nose is powerful and offers notes of orchard fruits, juicy peaches, pears, and yellow fruit. The palate is round, fresh, and balanced. It presents a beautiful and lively effervescence of great finesse.
- 6      **Bollinger Special Cuvee NV, Ay, France**      £95.00  
A golden colour with a beautifully fine mousse. The nose is aromatic and complex with ripe fruit and spicy aromas. Roasted apples, apple compote and peaches burst on the palate. Brioche and notes of fresh walnut linger on the lasting finish.
- 7      **Laurent Perrier Rosé NV Champagne, Tiurs-sur-Marne, France**      £120.00  
Fruit dominates the palate. Cuvée Rosé Laurent-Perrier is a lively, well-rounded wine which combines structure and freshness. The forthright, slightly sharp attack is like breathing the heady aromas of a freshly picked basket of berry fruits- a symphony of aromas with a gently rounded, tender finish.

## White Wine

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| 8  | <b>Custoza Cantina del Garda, Vento, Italy</b>   | £27.00 |
|    | Blend of Cortese, Garganega and Trebbiano. Intense, aromatic nose with floral notes. Harmonious and fresh.   |        |
| 9  | <b>Chardonnay La Bourgade 2024 , Pays d'Oc, France</b>   | £29.00 |
|    | The wine is fresh and vibrant on entry to the palate revealing hints of toasted hazelnut and vanilla, followed by a remarkable depth of flavour. Delicate floral notes complete the overall balance, while the long finish leaves lingering impressions of fruity, lightly toasted aromas. |        |
| 10 | <b>Sauvignon Blanc 2025 Roundstone Marlborough, New Zealand</b>  | £32.00 |
|    | Bright and aromatic bursting with tropical fruits with underlying herbal notes on the nose. On the palate the full freshening punch of the herbal notes shines through.  |        |
| 11 | <b>Viognier 2023 L'Autodidacte, Saint Jean D'Aumieres, France</b>  | £36.00 |
|    | Fruity, the nose reveals notes of exotic fruits and citrus fruits. The lively and tangy palate that gives way to a gourmet finish of white peach.  |        |
| 12 | <b>Gavi DOC 2024 La Smilla, Piemonte, Italy</b>  | £40.00 |
|    | Very flowery with aromas of acacia, peach and apple; full and persistent on the palate with hints of almond on the finish.   |        |
| 13 | <b>Pinot Gris 2024 Pa Road, Marlborough, New Zealand</b>   | £42.00 |
|    | The aromatics are brimming with nashi pear, quince, apple, and complex entry notes of spice and mace. Notes of honeysuckle and orange blossom also make an appearance, with a hint of apricot adding further decadence to the nose.  |        |
| 14 | <b>Albarino Taranis 2023 Rias Baixas, Spain</b>  | £42.00 |
|    | Brilliant straw yellow colour with greenish flashes,high intensity, very fruity (stone fruits) and floral,clean, silky, and powerful dry wine with a well-integrated acidity. It has a good structure and oiliness.  |        |

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| 15 | <b>Riesling (Dry) 2022 Cave Spring, Niagara Peninsula</b>   | £49.00  |
|    | Dry and medium in body; well extracted up front with a note of Key lime; the mid-palate shows a tense seam of saline acidity, with chalky, lemon pith grip beneath and a hint of wet stone; this mineral tone drives into a delicate yet persistent finish of white peach, dried apricot and lemon grass. |         |
| 16 | <b>Sancerre 2023 Laetitia Ducroux, Loire, France</b>  | £50.00  |
|    | Crisp and clean with fantastic purity of flavour and elegant mineral tones throughout. Bursting with ripe citrus fruit and supported by a core of zippy acidity. A long, lingering finish.  |         |
| 17 | <b>Saint Veran 2023 Domaine Gueugnon-Remond, Burgundy, France</b>   | £52.00  |
|    | Gorgeous nose, floral and lively. Elegant, really nice freshness with aromas of vanilla, apple and pear. It's a really beautiful wine   |         |
| 18 | <b>Chardonnay Schlossberg 2021 Neiss, Pfalz, Germany</b>  | £54.00  |
|    | Juicy, fruit driven, full-bodied, subtle oak aroma with quite a nice spiciness.   |         |
| 19 | <b>Petite Arvine Varone 2024, Valais, Switzerland</b>   | £58.00  |
|    | Intense nose, citrus fruits, grapefruit, exotic fruits, stewed fruit of rhubarb; in the mouth, vivacity, elegance, harmony, fruit complexity, nice lemon-flavour acidity with a salt note at the end.   |         |
| 20 | <b>Chablis 1er Cru 2022 Mont de Milieu, Meuliere, France</b>  | £65.00  |
|    | Prominent aromas of ripe grapes, juicy citrus and soft peaches over subtle floral characteristics. Classical in style, the palate is supported by a mineral core showcasing the nuances of the terroir.   |         |
| 21 | <b>Condrieu 2022 E Guigal, Rhone, France</b>  | £90.00  |
|    | Golden yellow with intense aromas of violets, apricots, peaches and citrus. A fresh, round palate with low acidity.   |         |
| 22 | <b>Puligny-Montrachet 'Les Charmes' 2023 Dupont-Fahn, France</b>  | £120.00 |
|    | Big, rich, and nicely oaky, exuding flavours of apple pie, lemon meringue and orange citrus and baking spices.  |         |

## Red Wine

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| 23 | <b>Montepulciano Il Caggio 2022, Abruzzo, Italy</b>   | £27.00 |
|    | This deeply coloured red wine is full-bodied and juicy. Combinations of black and red fruit flavours are complemented by a twist of spice on the palate.  |        |
| 24 | <b>Pinot Noir La Bourgade 2024 , Pays d'Oc, France</b>  | £29.00 |
|    | The wine's ruby colour, with vibrant highlights, invites you to take a sip. The nose reveals notes of spice and ripe red fruits, including cherry and raspberry. On entry to the palate, the wine is fresh and elegant, with a pleasing softness, while the silky, mellow tannins provide a pleasant, harmonious texture. |        |
| 25 | <b>Malbec 'Chacabuco' 2024 Los Haroldos, Mendoza, Argentina</b>   | £32.00 |
|    | Having the bright red fruit of a good Malbec this wine is medium bodied and well balanced. Smoky tannins support raspberry, plum and cassis flavours alongside a healthy dose of aromatic wood and spice.   |        |
| 26 | <b>Rioja Crianza 2021 Palacio de Otono ,Rioja, Spain</b>  | £36.00 |
|    | Complex aromas of ripe blackberries and gentle smoky red berries. Incredible concentration and depth on the palate with soft bramble fruits supported by underlying notes of earthy spice and vanilla.  |        |
| 27 | <b>Côtes du Rhône Villages 2023 Secret des Galets, France</b>   | £40.00 |
|    | Intense coloured, dark red wine with mauve reflections, which releases generous berry and spice flavours. The texture of this wine is pleasant, structured and round on the palate. The tannins are smooth and offer a beautiful fruity persistence.  |        |
| 28 | <b>Scruffy's Shiraz, Nugan Estate, 2023, Australia</b>  | £42.00 |
|    | Dark purple in colour with spicy blackcurrant and cherry aromas all complimented with floral oils. Intense flavours of juicy plum and blackcurrant combine with a touch of savoury spice.   |        |
| 29 | <b>Zinfandel 2022 Long Barn, California, USA</b>  | £25.00 |
|    | A soft and juicy Californian Zinfandel made by Italian winemaker Stefano Migotto. Round in the mouth with notes of sweet black cherries, brambles and chewy tannins. Oak ageing gives a vanilla and toasty character which lasts long into the finish.  |        |
| 30 | <b>Fleurie 2023 Montangeron, Beaujolais, France</b>   | £50.00 |
|    | Elegant and velvety in texture with characteristic perfumed aromas of delicate floral notes and ripe red berries. The palate shows good weight and depth of bramble flavour which provides the structure enabling this wine to age. Soft blackcurrant and subtle violet notes throughout lead to long silky finish.       |        |

- 31      **Ricasoli Brolio Chianti Classico 2023, Tuscany, Italy**      £52.00  
Intense ruby red colour. Complex nose with fruity aromas of red fruits, plums, balsamic hints and vanilla scents. The entry is firm but elegant, with sweet tannins and balanced acidity. The finish is long with excellent persistence. It is the “grand vin” of Brolio.
- 32      **Hochar 2019 Chateau Musar, Lebanon**      £56.00  
Full flavoured with rich ripe berries, stewed stone fruit and a subtle cedar and spice character. The wine is smooth and balanced with soft harmony- seductive and immensely appealing.
- 33      **Reserve Collection Cab Sauvignon 2021 Tokara, Stellenbosch, S Africa**      £62.00  
This wine has a beautiful bright claret colour. There are aromas of brambleberry coulis, subtle cassis and blackberry on the nose complimented by underlying notes of five spice and the slightest hint of vanilla. The palate is packed with delicious dark fruit interwoven in spice and light toasty notes from the barrels. A tannin profile reminiscent of silky dark chocolate with poised freshness round off the finish.
- 34      **Amarone 2018 San Cassiano, Veneto, Italy**      £68.00  
The wine has a lovely and intense dark garnet colour. It exudes aromas and flavours of black cherries, chocolate, coffee, and raisins, along with a note of almonds.
- 35      **Chateau Belgrave Haut Medoc 2015, Bordeaux, France**      £75.00  
The wine is almost black in colour, displaying dark red glints and a delicate purple rim. The complex, intensely fresh bouquet opens on toasty notes, enhanced by powerful black fruit aromas. The wine is all-enveloping and characterised by an elegant, powerful, tight structure and silky, concentrated tannins. It evolves towards an impressively long finish, revealing attractive oaky notes. Magnificent Belgrave, very Saint-Julien in style.
- 36      **Nuits Saint Georges, 2019 Bouchard Pere & Fils, Burgundy, France**      £90.00  
Intense aromas of berry fruit and spices on the nose. Rich, tannic and well structured, this wine develops additional roundness after a few years in bottle. Good ageing potential.
- 37      **Gevrey Chambertin 2021 Domaine Harmand Geoffroy, France**      £120.00  
A more layered if still somewhat fruity nose combines notes of herbal tea, forest floor, red currant, and soft wood influence. The mouthfeel of the barely middle weight flavours is finer if not necessarily more concentrated, all wrapped in a mildly austere and tender finish.

## Rose Wine

- 38     **Pinot Grigio Rose 2024 Cara Amica, Veneto, Italy**     £25.00  
Characterized by notes of fragrant summer fruits on the nose and delicate strawberry fruit on the palate.
- 39     **Saint Louis de Provence Rose 2023, Estandon, France**     £38.00  
The wine displays a pale pink hue with bluish tints. The nose is complex, opening up with notes of wild strawberries, raspberries and white flowers. The palate is broad and harmonious, with notes of raspberry. This rosé is a real treat!

## Dessert Wine

- 40     **Sauternes 2022 Chateau Jany, Bordeaux, France**     £35.00  
On the nose, the wine has notes of grapefruit and lemon but also dried fruits (apricot and mango). In the mouth, it is ample, rich and velvety.
- 41     **Rutherglen Muscat, NV, Campbells, Australia**     £40.00  
Deep amber with tawny hues. Rich fresh raisin fruit aromas with great depth and showing some rancio characters. Great power and intense fruit with balance and elegance. There is evidence of mellow oak with the luscious lingering finish.
- 42     **Riesling Ice Wine 2023 Cave Springs, Canada**     £60.00  
The nose is highly aromatic with aromas of peach, apricot and Bartlett pear over top notes of exotic citrus, spice and comb honey. The palate is full and sweet with a round, seamless feel, gently lifted by well-integrated acidity throughout. Rich flavours of sultana raisins, dried apricot and orange marmalade dominate, carrying with great intensity alongside nuances of pear preserve long onto the finish.
